

Petition to Use Historical Coursework (More Than 10 Years Old) Toward a Current Graduate Degree Program

Coursework and credits more than 10 years old, whether taken at UB or another institution, must be petitioned at the time of the student’s admission to a current program, if they are to be applied toward the current degree. The director of graduate studies for the student’s program reviews the coursework to determine whether the content of those courses is still relevant and applicable to the current program. The student must demonstrate their continued knowledge of the course content.
